Hose Bibs and Vents:


During the month of October, we will be putting on hose bib covers and closing foundation vents throughout the community. We will place door hangers on the homes that need to be entered for these purposes. We will make sure and give you plenty of notice.

Smoke Detectors:

Now is a great time to check your smoke detectors. If you have not changed the batteries in the last six months or more, now is a good time to do so. If you need help changing the batteries, please submit a work order through the Woodscape Glen website (www.woodscapeglen.com). Go to the "Current Residents" tab and scroll to the bottom of the page. You will find the Maintenance Request Form there.

Security:

Crime is up, so being vigilant is one of our best tools to keep secure. Parking your vehicle in the garage will keep it from being vandalized. Remember to lock up any outside vehicles and do not leave valuables, keys or garage remotes in them. Keeping your outside lights on at night helps as well. White Bean 'n' Ham Soup

Ingredients:

- * 2 cans (15 ½ ounces each) great northern (or navy) beans, rinsed and drained.
- * 2 medium carrots, diced.
- * 1 medium celery, diced.
- * 1 small onion, chopped.
- * 2 tablespoons butter or margarine.
- * 2 ½ cups of water or chicken stock.
- * 1 ½ cups cubed, fully cooked ham.
- * ½ teaspoon salt.
- * 1/8 to ½ teaspoon pepper.
- * 1 bay leaf.

Directions:

- 1. Mash one can of beans; set aside.
- 2. In a large saucepan, sauté the carrots, celery and onion in butter.
- 3. Stir in the water (or stock if using), ham, seasonings and whole and mashed beans.
- 4. Cook over medium heat until heated through.
- 5. Discard bay leaf before serving.
